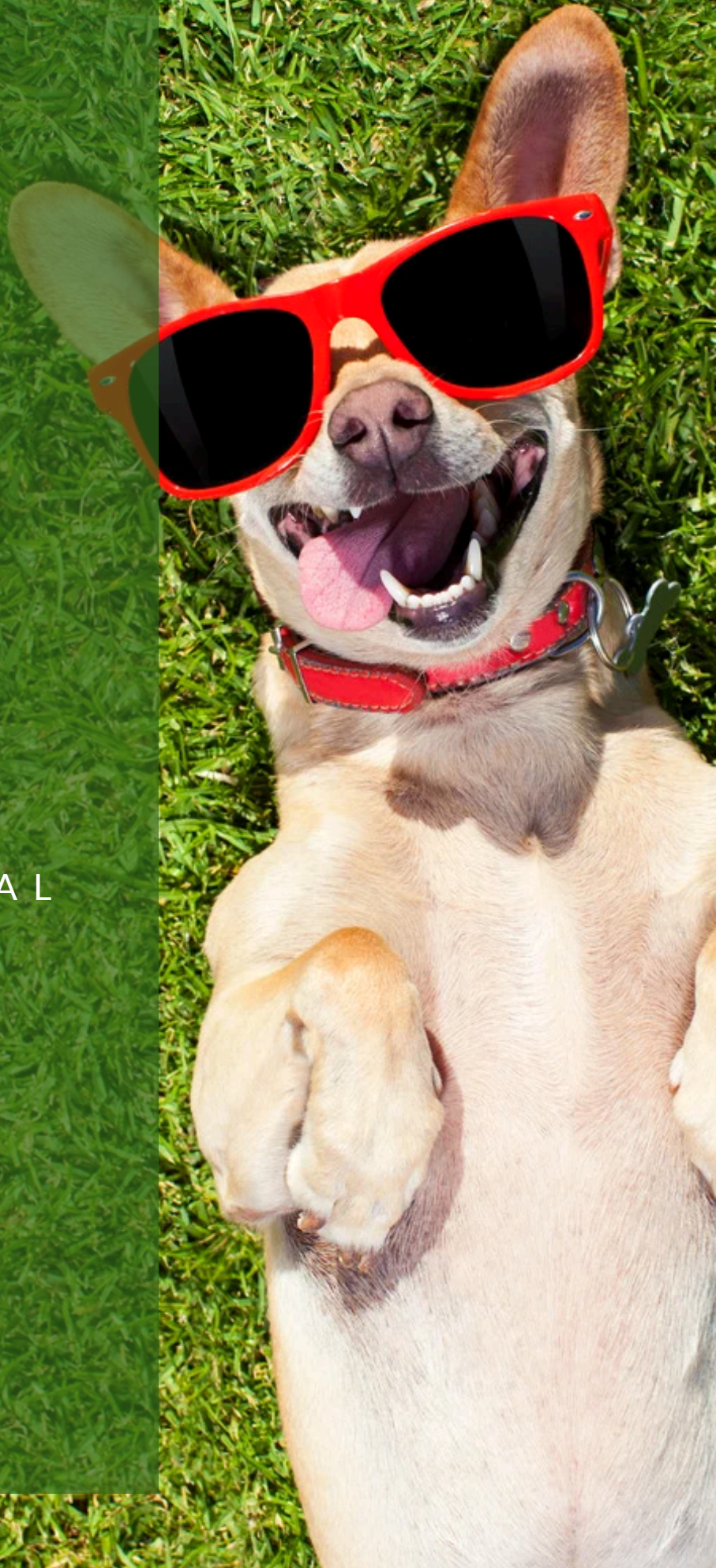

DUTIES





APPLY



To keep pups and people safe, our Dog Park Ambassadors pass an application/background check process prior to volunteering. Background checks are repeated annually.



DUTIES

Schedules are flexible, but generally volunteers donate in 30 min - 1 hour increments.

WELCOME

- Wear a volunteer dog park ambassador lanyard to identify yourself to guests.
- Welcome and greet dog park users and their furry friends.
- Ensure users have their dog park permit visible.
- Inform users of the annual dog park permit purchase requirements, the dog park rules and good "pet-iquette".

WALK

- Make sure the dog park is a clean, safe, and inviting space, both inside and outside of the park.
- Walk, pick up trash, and check the following:
 - Dog Park Waste Bags
 - Entrance
 - Parking
 - Perimeter
- As needed:
 - fill the dog park waste bags (extras in on-site storage).
 - pick up dog waste.

REPORT

- Please report to Supervisor Anthony Leo, amleo@dmgov.org or (515)238-4825 any of the following:
 - holes in the ground
 - holes in the fence
 - hanging tree limbs
 - unsafe conditions
 - empty dog bag supply
 - if an emergency is reported to the police
- **EMERGENCY, dial 911.** For less urgent (non-emergency) police issues, call 515-283-4811.

FAQ

Can I bring my dog with me?

You'll need to have a valid dog park permit for your pup when you begin.

Ambassadors who volunteer throughout the year, will receive a FREE dog park permit. (for the following year).

Dog Parks Open Daily 6 a.m.-10 p.m.

All parks contain a dog waste station and picnic tables.

Ewing Dog Park

4660 Indianola Avenue

- 8.5 acres fenced area for all dogs
- 1 acre of fenced area for dogs 20 lbs. or less
- Open-air shelter
- Drinking fountain (May-October).

Reno Memorial Dog Park

3325 Hubbell Avenue

- 4.2 acres fenced area
- Half-mile hard surface walking path
- Flat terrain with a mix of tall and short grass
- Mature trees

Riverwalk Dog Park

1111 Illinois Street

- 4 acres of fenced area
- On-street parking
- 2 ADA Parking Stalls
- 2 fenced unleashing areas
- Enclosed portable restroom
- Easy access to nearby Principal Riverwalk and trails
